ETM-LA is proud to recognize three Shining Star Honorees: Christophe Beck, Lydia Lee, and SEL4CA. Each honoree continues to affect positive change in the lives of others through music and the arts.

ETM-LA's mission is to provide and promote music education in systemically marginalized schools across Los Angeles County in order to nurture students' academic, social-emotional, and overall development. In 18 years, ETM-LA has grown from reaching two schools and 800 students, to 40 schools and approximately 19,000 students across Los Angeles County. Our approach - to provide sequential, comprehensive year-long music education in under-resourced schools and top-notch teacher professional development - has been recognized regionally and replicated nationally; its positive impact is undeniable.

We witness daily the joy and tangible effects in our schools: increased student motivation for learning, greater self-confidence, deepened empathy among peers, greater parent engagement, and more. Music is helping our youth build harmony and bridges to others at a critical age. Music is teaching our youth how to engage in this world as a public and global citizen.

Our collective work over nearly two decades has provided: 155,000+ music classes, 190,000+ students receiving music education, and 60,000+ professional development hours for teachers. Furthermore, our teacher career pathways, including a robust Music Teacher Intern Program, continue to respond to the wide shortage of music teachers in California and across the nation.

With your support, ETM-LA continues to offer a solution to create sustainable, year-long music programs for children who do not otherwise have the opportunity to receive formal music instruction. Through music, children develop into thoughtful leaders who are able to deepen their understanding of themselves and the world around them.







SHINING STAR HONOREES



CHRISTOPHE BECK Shining Star Artist

Canadian composer Christophe Beck started piano lessons at five, and by eleven he was learning Bee Gees songs by ear and performing with his first-ever band, the unfortunatelynamed Chris and The Cupcakes. During high school he studied piano, saxophone, and drums, and wrote many tender 80's love ballads. While studying music at Yale, Beck wrote two musicals with his brother Jason (aka Chilly Gonzales), as well as an opera based on "The Tell-Tale Heart" by Edgar Allen Poe.

Upon graduation, Beck moved to Los Angeles to attend USC's prestigious film scoring program, where he studied with Jerry Goldsmith. A personal recommendation from the legendary Buddy Baker, then head of the USC Music Department, led to his first assignment for a Canadian TV series called White Fang. Several TV series later, he was asked to score the second season of WB Network's Buffy the Vampire Slayer. Beck received the Emmy Award for Outstanding Music Composition for his score to the Buffy episode, "Becoming, Part 1."

In 2000, the cheerleading comedy Bring It On launched Beck's film career, which includes such diverse credits as Under The Tuscan Sun, Edge of Tomorrow, Crazy Stupid Love, Pitch Perfect, and the Hangover trilogy. Beck is best known for his collaborations with Disney, which include composing the soundtracks of The Muppets and Muppets Most Wanted, Frozen and its sequel, Frozen II, the Marvel Cinematic Universe films Ant-Man, Ant-Man and the Wasp, and Ant-Man and the Wasp: Quantumania as well as its TV miniseries WandaVision and Hawkeye for Marvel Studios, and Free Guy for 20th Century Studios, as well as the company's 100th anniversary logo. He also composed the music for the 2023 DC Extended Universe film Shazam! Fury of the Gods.

Christophe works out of his studio in Santa Monica, California and joined the Advisory Board of Education Through Music-Los Angeles in 2011.



LYDIA LEE Shining Star Music Educator

Lydia Lee is the vocal music director at John Muir Middle School in Burbank, California. Born in San Francisco, she started taking piano lessons at age 4, when she discovered she had a great connection to music. Lydia lived all up and down the west coast in her youth, and therefore got to experience different school music programs. Some of them were rigorous, others weak. In high school, she developed a love for singing, and so she decided to focus her studies there. ...

• **SEL Day**: SEL Day is a global, grassroots campaign for SEL to support children's academic recovery, mental health, and wellbeing. Since its inception in 2020, #SELday has reached over 40 million households. In 2023, all 50 U.S. states and 87 countries participated in SEL Day. Our advocacy efforts have resulted in SEL Day proclamations in fifteen states, a letter of support from the White House, and a bipartisan resolution for SEL Week introduced in the Senate. SEL4CA successfully obtained an SEL Day proclamation from Governor Newsom.

Her program includes over 160 students from 6th-8th grade, divided into 4 choirs. They perform 4 school concerts a year. Incorporating choreography along with their vocals, her show choirs have won numerous competitions, placed superior at music festivals, and have been invited to sing with famous bands like Foreigner, and musician Gene Simmons. Aside from teaching music full time, Lydia has performed with the LA Opera and has participated in various vocal recording projects.

Lydia is indebted to the many music teachers, private and public, who have taught her how to find joy in learning music. She endeavors to instill this joy in her own students. When not busy with school rehearsals, fundraising and performances, Lydia enjoys spending time with her husband, 16 year-old daughter, 5 year-old son, and 15 fruit trees.

The Social Emotional Learning Alliance for California (SEL4CA) is a Non-Profit Organization that advocates for the well-being of our schools, educators, and students through the advancement of transformative SEL as the cornerstone of how we educate in California.

Social Emotional Learning (SEL) is the process by which children develop critical life-skills

needed to navigate successfully in school and beyond; skills such as empathy, compassion, resiliency, responsibility, collaboration, critical thinking, healthy relationships, and good decision-making. Decades of research inform us that SEL is foundational to all learning, and SEL is proven to support academic success.

SEL4CA works with strategic partners in both the public and private sectors to bring evidence-based and innovative opportunities, programs, and curriculum - in the arts, music, dance, and beyond - that support the well-being of both students and teachers. We do this through engaging all stakeholders in the advocacy of SEL policy and practice, educator support and training, and grant-making for teachers and SEL providers to expand on the great work already happening in California schools.

Our current initiatives include addressing the youth mental health crisis and teacher burnout and shortages. We support educators through free training and resources, professional learning opportunities and discounted tuition for further education, teacher well-being resources and events, and by providing micro-grants for educators working to bring SEL to their schools and classrooms.






Kristen Bell

Kristen Bell is an actress, philanthropist, author, and entrepreneur. Kristen voiced Princess Anna in the global blockbusters *Frozen* and *Frozen* 2. Her feature film credits include: Bad Moms, Bad Moms Christmas, Like Father, CHIPs, The Lifeguard, Hit & Run, You Again, Couples Retreat, and Forgetting Sarah Marshall. Her Broadway credits include The Adventures of Tom Sawyer and Arthur Miller's The Crucible and her Off-Broadway credits include Reefer Madness and A Little Night Music. Kristen is actively involved in many charities including Alliance of Moms, Baby2Baby and Charity Water. She is also a global advocate for the UN's Women's Peace & Humanitarian Fund.



Bryan Cranston

An Academy Award nominee, and an Emmy, Screen Actors Guild, Tony, and Olivier Award winner. He most recently starred on the second season of Showtime's hit drama series, Your Honor, which he also executive produced. On the big screen, Cranston re-teamed with Wes Anderson in the critically acclaimed ensemble feature, Asteroid City - which premiered at the 2023 Cannes Film Festival. Additionally, Cranston will star in Matthew Vaughn's Argylle, which will be released in February.

Cranston made his Broadway debut as President Lyndon B. Johnson in All the Way and produced the HBO film adaptation through his production company, Moonshot Entertainment. In 2018, Cranston starred as the iconic Howard Beale in Ivo van Hove's Network on London's West End and on Broadway. Cranston is best known for his portrayal of two very different characters - Hal on the sit-com Malcolm in the Middle, and Walter White on the drama series, Breaking Bad. Cranston is a New York Times bestselling author with, A Life in Parts, a memoir of the many parts he's played on and off camera. In 2019, Cranston and his Breaking Bad co-star, Aaron Paul, released an artisanal Mezcal, "Dos Hombres", which has grown to become the 5th bestselling mezcal in the United States.



Chris Columbus

Academy Award®-nominated director, writer and producer Chris Columbus is best known for having written, directed and produced some of the most successful and iconic box-office hits, including HOME ALONE, HARRY POTTER AND THE SORCERER'S STONE, where he cast newcomers Daniel Radcliffe, Emma Watson and Rupert Grint in the leading roles, HARRY POTTER AND THE CHAMBER OF SECRETS, MRS. DOUBTFIRE, STEPMOM and RENT, among many other critically acclaimed films. Columbus first gained prominence by writing several original

scripts produced by Steven Spielberg, including GREMLINS, THE GOONIES and YOUNG SHERLOCK HOLMES. In 2011, Columbus produced the blockbuster hit THE HELP, which received four Academy Award® nominations, including two for Best Supporting Actress and one for Best Picture. In 2013, he teamed up with his daughter, Eleanor Columbus, to form Maiden Voyage Pictures, where they produced PATTI CAKE\$ and MENASHE, both nominated for "Best First Feature" at the Film Independent Spirit Awards. Maiden Voyage's other film credits include Robert Eggers' THE WITCH and THE LIGHTHOUSE, Sara Colangelo's LITTLE ACCIDENTS, Sian Heder's TALLULAH and Karen Maine's "YES, GOD, YES". Maiden Voyage won the 2022 Sundance Grand Jury Prize for Violet Columbus and Ben Klein's documentary, "THE EXILES" and are now in production on Robert Eggers' latest film, "NOSFERATU". Columbus most recently directed, co-wrote and produced through his production company 26th Street Pictures, the fan favorite film THE CHRISTMAS CHRONICLES 2. Starring Kurt Russell and Goldie Hawn, the film was released on Netflix in November 2020.



Kait Dunton

KAIT DUNTON is a Los Angeles-based keyboardist, composer and bandleader with eight albums of genre-pushing original music and hundreds of thousands of followers on social media and Spotify. Kait's joyful energy and playful spirit combined with her raw emotional style have garnered her a devoted fanbase whom she invites to live in the moment right alongside her. Starting with her first album, Real & Imagined-now a fan favorite with over three million streams-Kait has continued to cultivate her signature sound over many subsequent

She records often for film, television and other artists, and has taught at the University of North Texas, USC's Thornton School of Music, Musician's Institute, Chaffey College, and most recently at Los Angeles College of Music (LACM) in Pasadena, where she developed their new Piano Performance program and served as the inaugural chair.


Jake Reed Kait Dunton Band


